COUNCIL MINUTES SUMMARY
June 24, 2020

- 1) **Devotions:** Tom Hordyk opened by reading 1 Timothy 3:1-14 and led in prayer. Council sang TPH #95C
- 2) **Business Arising from Minutes/ New Business**
 - A. Reopening for worship services: The latest government regulations were discussed. A plan for opening services to about 100 people per service was discussed. New groups of 20 members will be formed to accommodate this with a plan to start on July 5th. Further information will be sent to the congregation by email and the elders will be contacting members in their districts.
 - B. Election of Office Bearers: Council discussed nominees to fill 3 elder positions and 2 deacon positions. Nominees will be contacted by the elders.
 - C. The process for conducting the Lord's Supper was discussed. The Lord's Supper is to be held in the morning and evening service on July 12th, and possibly on July 19th.
- 3) **Correspondence:**
 - A. An email was received from Pastor Enrie Langendoen regarding his work among migrant workers.
- 4) **Reports:**
 - A. **Deacon Reports:** Collections continue via electronic transfer and cheques mailed to the deacons. The deacons continue to remain in contact with those needing assistance. Deacons continue to maintain contact with the congregation by phone. The deacons plan to hold an offering for the family of Pastor Corey Dykstra in early July.
 - B. **Elder Reports:** Elders continue to reach out to the congregation by phone. Several concerns regarding members with ongoing health issues were discussed.
 - C. **Pastor's Report:** Pastor Anjema will be attending the CanRC Classis meeting in Carman on June 26th, 2020. He will also exchange with Pastor Poppe on June 28th.
