1) **Devotions:** Tom Hordyk opened by reading Psalm 39 and then led in prayer.

2) Business Arising from Minutes/ New Business

- A. Additional insurance issues related to church use were discussed.
- B. The FM transmitter has arrived and it is now installed and functional. Services can now be picked up on car radios in the church parking lot. Also, services are being live streamed to the parking lot via the church internal WIFI network. Devices such as cell phones can connect directly to the network to see the service. Information was placed in the bulletin on how to connect to these services.
- C. Profession and Catechism classes are to be restarted the week of March 14th. Information to follow.
- D. Tom Hordyk provided a summary of the ARPA meeting he attended. Bill C-6 and C-7 were discussed, as well as court cases regarding reopening of churches in B.C. and Manitoba.
- E. Book Study: Postponed. Pastor Anjema will lead the review Chapter 5 "Elders and Deacons as Hospitality Leaders" at next meeting.
- F. Three services will be held each Sunday at 9:30AM, 11:30AM and 4PM. This will allow the entire congregation to attend a worship service at least once each Sunday, based on the building's capacity.
